

## Opportunity for Public Input and Comment on

### Dodge County Human Services 2010-11 Biennial Service Agreement for the Minnesota Family Investment Program (MFIP) and Children and Community Services Act (CCSA)

State law requires that Dodge County Human Services submits a biennial service agreement to access consolidated funding for the Minnesota Family Investment Program ( MFIP) and the Children and Community Services Act (CCSA) for human services in 2010-11. This funding includes federal Social Services Block Grant (Title XX) funds and other federal and state funds. The primary purpose of the service agreement and the consolidated funding model is to achieve stated outcomes and work toward goals of *economic stability for low-income families* under MFIP, and *keeping children safe and improving their well-being* under CCSA.

With this notice, we are soliciting public input and comments with respect to what Dodge County Human Services should consider in preparing the agreement. For consideration in this process, any comments or input must be received by **by 9 a.m. on Monday, November 23, 2009** at:
