

DODGE COUNTY VOLUNTEER POSTING: Dodge County Sheriff's Posse

We consider all applicants regardless of race, color, religion, creed, gender, sexual orientation, national origin, age, disability, marital status, or any other legally protected status.

POSITION TITLE: Dodge County Sheriff's Posse Member (Volunteer)

DATE OF CLOSING: Open until filled.

ACCOUNTABLE TO: Dodge County Sheriff

HOURS: Vary depending on events.

JOB PURPOSE: To help maintain peace, order and the law in our community; to be public spirited; to promote good fellowship; to cooperate with peace officers and with similar county organizations.

PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Promotes community safety and assists Sheriff's Department.
2. Strengthening communities through commitment and generosity.
3. All active posse members must contribute a minimum of 100 hours per year towards scheduled posse activities. (Easily obtained with attending monthly meeting & one scheduled event per month.)
4. Ride along with Deputies, uniformed patrol at all city events, fair, dances, parades, search for lost or missing persons.
5. Attend monthly meetings/training (third Monday of each month, 7:00 p.m. at the Courthouse).

JOB REQUIREMENTS: Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other posse members, the Sheriff's Department staff, and the general public. Applicants must reside in the Dodge County, State of Minnesota, and shall be confined to persons over the age of twenty-one (21) and of good moral character. (Applications received from individuals who live outside the county will be reviewed on a per case basis. Individuals 18 years of age and older will be considered if applying to an accredited Law Enforcement School.)

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Ability to contribute at a minimum 100 hours per year. CPR certification desirable. Field Training must be completed in a two month time period.

MISCELEANOUS INFORMATION: Volunteering is a great way to make a difference in Dodge County and give back to your communities. Applicants will go through a Field Training Program with one-on-one training with a Deputy. The Dodge County Sheriff's Posse is a nonprofit organization. Background checks will be completed on all applicants. Each applicant must complete a probationary training period.
