**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KASSON ,
MINNESOTA**

**AMENDING THE CITY CODE BY ADDING
CHAPTER 19.1, REGARDING ALL-TERRAIN
VEHICLES**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KASSON ,
MINNESOTA DOES ORDAIN:

Chapter 19.1 shall be Added to the City Code and shall read as follows:

CHAPTER 19.1. ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES.

Sec. 19.1-1. State regulations--Adoption.

Sections 84.92, 84.928 and 84.929 of the Minnesota Statutes are hereby adopted as the all-terrain vehicle regulations of the city and are hereby made a part of this chapter as if fully set forth herein.

Sec. 19.1-2. Operation generally--When prohibited.

No person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle within the city limits upon public property or upon private property after the hours of 10:00 P.M. or before 9:00 A.M., Sunday through Thursday. On Friday and Saturday, no person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle within the city limits upon public property or upon private property after midnight or before 9:00 A.M. The operation of all-terrain vehicles within the city limits during the hours allowed shall be strictly limited to travel by the shortest and most direct route to and from the operators home to areas outside of the city limits. The city council may, at its discretion, allow all-terrain vehicles to be operated outside of the hours allowed for special events. Permission for all-terrain vehicle groups and clubs to operate all-terrain vehicles outside of the hours allowed shall be obtained only from the city council at a regular meeting thereof. All-terrain vehicles may not be operated at any time within the city limits in a manner other than as provided above.

Sec. 19.1-3. Same--Where permitted; limitations.

(a) During the hours enumerated in the preceding section, the operation of all-terrain vehicles will be limited to the following streets:

(1) Second Avenue Southwest (from CSAH 34 southerly to Fifth Street Southeast);

(2) Veterans Memorial Highway West (from Mantorville Avenue to 8th Avenue SW);

(3) Eighth Avenue Southwest and Northwest;

- (4) Fifth Street Northwest (from Fourth Avenue NW westerly);
 - (5) Fourth Avenue Northwest (from Fifth Street NW to Seventh Street NW);
 - (6) Seventh Street Northwest and Northeast;
 - (7) First Avenue Northeast (from Main Street to Seventh Street NE).
 - (8) Fifth Street Southeast (from Second Avenue Southwest easterly);
 - (9) Commerce Drive Southeast;
 - (10) Third Street Southeast ;
 - (11) Eighth Ave SE (from CSAH 34 to Third Street Southeast)
- (b) No all-terrain vehicle shall cross Main Street between Eighth Avenue Northwest and First Avenue Northeast.
- (c) It is unlawful to operate an all-terrain vehicle upon private property without written permission of the owner or person entitled to possession and use of such property, and upon any school grounds, park property, playgrounds or recreation area or any other public property.
- (d) All all-terrain vehicles operated on the above described streets shall only use that portion of the roadway ordinarily used for vehicular traffic.

Sec. 19.1-4. Same--Right-of-way; obedience to state law.

All-terrain vehicles shall at all times yield the right-of-way at every

intersection and shall be operated in accordance with the state traffic laws and the provisions of this code and other ordinances of the city.

Anyone operating an all-terrain vehicle in the City of Kasson must have a valid driver's license and insurance.

Sec. 19.1-5. Same--Speed limits.

It is unlawful to operate an all-terrain vehicle within the corporate city limits of the city at a rate of speed greater than fifteen miles per hour.

Sec. 19.1-6. Penalty for violation.

Violation of this chapter is a misdemeanor.

Sec. 19.1-7. Duration of this Chapter

This Chapter of the Municipal Code will expire June 1, 2005.

This Ordinance is effective from and after its publication. Adopted this 23rd day of June, 2004.
