 - Drive-thru distribution in the WEST parking lot starting in April (1st T/TH of the month).
 - April 7th 12-3pm
 - April 9th 4-7pm
 - Staff requests that families stay in their cars and 2 brown grocery bags of food will be delivered to their car. Foods include: canned F/Vs, PB, mac and cheese, bread, milk, hot dogs, hamburger and TP.
 - Recipients are required to show proof of Dodge County residency and can only pick up for their own family (do not send one person to pick up for multiple families).
 - In dire need, families can call the church office and a food package will be made available to them outside of set distribution times, if possible.

 - NAPS boxes will continue to be delivered to the food shelf and will be distributed to individual seniors that qualify.
 - If you are a Dodge County resident that needs to sign up, call the office at 507-634-4350 and intake will be done over the phone.
 - Hours Tuesday & Thursday, 8am-12:30pm & 1:30-4pm
